

ACHIEVEMENTS ✓

1. 36 students participated in Interschool handball competition in U-14, U-17 and U-19 category, The teams U-14, and U-17 lifted the champions trophy. 6 in U-14, 5 in U-17 and 3 in U-19 represented Indore division at state level.
2. A powerful 12 members contingent participated in west zone C.B.S.E. handball tournament where 49 teams from 6 states participated. The school team brought laurels by winning the tournament and qualified for Nationals.

4. 5 students participated in Malkhamb at State level and secured third position.



THE SCHOOL PANORAMA

Healthy atmosphere is prerequisite for healthy growth. SBSSS is situated in the lap of nature and surrounded by meadows and hills. The location of school is perfectly in harmony with nature. The school surrounding is echoed by Shlokas in morning and fragrance of prayers is ever felt here.

The school is affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education and conducts classes from Nursery to XII. Spread over 20 acres of land, the school has a three-story building for senior classes and double storey building for 15 primary sections, four well equipped laboratories, a rich library, an auditorium, double storied hostels, spacious playgrounds, staff quarters, a Goshala and beautiful Yati Niwas and magnificent

ADMISSION POLICY

Admission form along with prospectus will be available in the school office on payment of ` 500/-. The Prospectus would be available by post on payment of ` 600/-.

Admission procedure for Nursery to class IX will start from the month of Dec. for Nursery to UKG there will not be any written test or entrance exam, there will only be interaction with the children.

For seeking admission for class I to IX the child after registration has to appear for entrance examination. A suitable day and date will be given to the student for the test and entrance test will be conducted as follows:

HEALTHY EATING

We hope that parents will support the Schools Meals Service whenever possible because we strongly believe in the social benefits of eating together in a 'family' atmosphere.

The school provides pure nutritionally balanced, delicious meal to the students with all seasonal fresh vegetables. As the school has its own Gaushala, the students are getting pure and fresh milk of the cow

twice a day, once in the morning and then during the dinner. Children are encouraged to drink water freely throughout the day.

The captains and Vice Captains are always engaged in distribution of food under supervision of the House masters and teachers.





THE EXPECTATIONS OF THE SCHOOL FROM THE PARENTS

01. Fee should be deposited on decided dates during school working hours.
02. The name of student will be strike out if without permission he/she remains absent from the school for period of complete week. To enroll the name again, ₹ 500/- will be charged.
03. Irregular absence from the school will be charged ₹ 200/- per day.
04. Without prior proper written permission, parents are not allowed to take their ward out from the school campus.
05. For every irregularity from their side, parents will be responsible. 90% presence of the students in the school is compulsory otherwise he/she would be discarded from the Annual Examination.
06. Communicate with Principal, class teacher, hostel warden time to time in the reference of student's progress.
07. Parents will be allowed to meet their ward between 10am-4pm only on the First and third Sundays of every month. Except given time and day parents will not be allowed to meet their children.
08. It is parent's duty to take their child home during holidays and to bring them back on due dates after vacation is over.
